SUBJECT: Application for Amendment of NRC License 01-25316-01, Control No. 574032

1. Reference our telephone conversation of 01/04/2011 & your email of 01/06/2011 concerning application for amendment of NRC license 01-25316-01, Control No. 574032
2. As we discussed, the intent to add radium 226 to NRC License 01-25316-01 was essentially a preemptive consideration discussed during a recent license audit. After further consideration, it is concluded that any equipment we might obtain will likely be manufactured in a time frame after the common use of radium as an illumination component had ceased. Additionally, the overall program of receiving foreign material is being phased out at this time. These considerations serve to minimize the need for addition of Radium to our license in form or quantity that requires financial assurance.
3. We request the component of our license amendment request that contains the Radium addition be changed to include Ra-226 as a sealed source in the amount of 1 millicurie. As suggested in your email, between the general allowances and the sealed source amendment, this would further limit the risk of receiving something we were not licensed for.
