Center in Muscle Shoals, Alabama. In Reference 2, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission provided a request for additional information (RAI) regarding TVA's license termination request. Based on a review of the RAI, TVA determined additional time to locate and provide the requested information was required. In Reference 3, TVA stated that it would provide a schedule for submitting the information in response to the RAI by January 21, 2011. Subsequently, in Reference 4, the NRC voided TVA's application.

To inform NRC's planning process, TVA intends to submit a revised license termination application, including the information requested in Reference 2, by December 30, 2011.
