Please find enclosed the IFR for Reasonable Assurance for the PSEG site, submitted by the Radiological Emergency Preparedness (REP) Program staff from FEMA Region II and Region III offices. Both Regions' staffs have reviewed the information submitted on May 25, 2010, pertaining to the offsite radiological emergency plans for the PSEG site ESP application. Plans were reviewed against the fifteen (15) planning standards in NUREG-0654 FEMA REP-1, Revision 1.

Based on our thorough review of plans submitted, and the currently available offsite plans and procedures for the 10-mile Emergency Planning Zone, as well as the 50-mile Ingestion Pathway Zone, FEMA has determined that the plans are adequate, and there is Reasonable Assurance that the plans can be implemented with no corrections needed.
