Also on the call was Stephen Lemont of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, the project leader for the NRC's AREVA Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility EIS. On the call for the BLM was Bill Boggs, Wendy Reynolds, and Becky Lazdauskas.

The purpose of the call was to determine the BLM's opinion on how construction and operation of the EREF in the Idaho desert would effect surrounding visual resources. Bill Boggs is a visual resource specialist with the Bureau of Land Management Snake River Field Office. He indicated that the construction and operation of the EREF may affect the Visual Resource Inventory rating for the area. It was his opinion that the VRI rating would be reduced due to the presence of the EREF. He also indicated that the EREF would be very visible at night from a primary camping location within the Hell's Half Acre Wilderness Study Area(WSA). The lights from the EREF would have a negative impact on the nighttime views from the WSA camping area.
