Dr. Kolodziej,

Your response to Item 1.a. is incorrect. The sum of fractions for a combination of isotopes, where R divided by $1 \text{ E}+5 = 1.189$ requires that you provide a Decommissioning Funding Plan. The prescribed amount of \$1,125,000 is applicable if the sum of fractions divided by $1 \text{ E}+5$ was greater than 0.1 and less than or equal to 1. Because your sum of fractions exceeds 1, you must provide a DFP. The cost estimate determined by the DFP is the amount of financial assurance that you must provide. No additional response to Item 1.a. is required.

Thank you for the information in 1.b. No additional response to Item 1.b. is required.

We appreciate the information in 1.c, but may request additional information in the future, as our research indicates that some of these radionuclides are found in similar cyclotrons. At this time, no additional information is requested.

2. There was not a Decommissioning Funding Plan attached to your letter. Please submit the DFP for our review.

3. We cannot issue a waiver for submission of the Surety Bonds and applicable financial assurance documentation. However, we understand that the process of obtaining the financial assurance and supporting documents may take some time. We request periodic updates let us know of your progress, approximately monthly until the documents are submitted. Such updates may be provided by email.
