Public Meeting Summary: Meeting to Discuss Status of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory
Commission Monitoring Activities at the Saltstone Disposal Facility at the Savannah River Site
January 27, 2011

The meeting was transcribed by a Court Reporter. Since a transcript of this meeting is available (Attachment 2), this summary is only intended to include information on the background of the meeting and on its purpose; any additional information can be found in the transcript for the meeting. References in this document are provided as document accession numbers to the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS). Background

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) began preparing an update to the "Performance Assessment for the Saltstone Facility at the Savannah River Site" (PA) in 2007 and provided the document to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) upon its completion in November 2009 (ML101590008). The NRC began its review immediately and submitted its first Request for Additional Information (RAI) on March 31, 2010 (ML100820097). An RAI is a list of questions and/or comments the NRC staff must have answered by DOE before completing its review. The DOE provided responses to this RAI on July 22, 2010 (ML102090664). Upon review, the NRC staff found some of these responses to be insufficient and submitted a second RAI to the DOE on December 15, 2010 (ML103400571). The purpose of this meeting was for the NRC to provide the public an explanation of some of the NRC's concerns as identified during review of the PA and for the DOE to provide the public with an explanation of their disposal process at the Saltstone Facility as it relates to the NRC's concerns. All presentations and assisting documentation are provided as attachments to this summary and are listed below.

Summary

The NRC presentation lasted about 40 minutes and provided details of the NRC's review of the 2009 Saltstone PA. There were no questions following the presentation. The DOE presentation consisted of two presenters which lasted about 1 hour. The first DOE presentation focused on the review process and schedule and the second provided a technical overview of the saltstone facility and process and described plans for addressing the NRC's concerns. The DOE presentation ended with a summary that included a proposed April/May meeting with NRC on the 2nd RAIs and the development of a list that prioritizes the RAI's in order of resolution immediacy, those not in need of immediate resolution being addressed under the DOE PA maintenance program. Similarly, there were no questions at the end of DOE's presentation. The meeting was concluded with statements from NRC and DOE. The meeting was transcribed and a meeting summary including both NRC and DOE presentations will be created and made publicly available.
