MEMORANDUM AND ORDER
(Party Objections/Consent to Proposed Transcript Corrections)

In the Licensing Board's December 17, 2010 issuance outlining the process for providing proposed transcript corrections relative to the January 25, 2010 evidentiary hearing, we indicated that such corrections "should, to the maximum extent possible, reflect agreement among the parties." Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Providing Presentation Topics and Administrative Directives Associated with Mandatory Hearing on Safety Matters) (Dec. 17, 2010) at 14 (unpublished); see also 10 C.F.R. § 2.323(b). The motions to adopt proposed transcript corrections filed by the NRC staff and applicant AREVA Enrichment Services, LLC (AES) on February 4 and 7, 2011, respectively, do not indicate whether the parties consulted regarding their proposed corrections or whether either party objects to any of the corrections proposed by the other party.

Accordingly, on or before Thursday, February 10, 2011, AES and the staff shall providing a filing or filings advising the Board whether either has any objections to the pending proposed transcript corrections submitted by the other party.
