SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Dear Ms. Roughan:

This refers to your application dated January 7, 2011, requesting termination of your NRC exempt distribution License No. 20-12836-02E. We do not have sufficient information to complete the review of your application. In order to continue our review we ask that you provide a final product transfer report as described in the following paragraphs:

Your application stated, in part, that "no material was ever possessed under this license. . . ." However, the NRC has records of exempt-distribution transfer reports you submitted dated 1/17/2007, 4/24/2008, and 11/19/2010. It appears that a misunderstanding has occurred with regard to the requirements for reporting when a request is made for termination of an exempt-distribution license. The attachment to this letter lists the requirements that pertain to your license. Please provide a report in conformance with these regulations

As a minimum, you should file the report by one of the methods listed in Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 30, section 30.6(a). In addition, to facilitate the processing of your amendment request, please send a copy of your report directly to me at the following address:
