The purpose of this letter is to respond to the requests for additional information (RAI) identified in the NRC e-mail correspondence to UniStar Nuclear Energy, dated January 13, 2011 (References 1 and 2). These RAIs address the Liquid and Gaseous Waste Management Systems, as discussed in Sections 11.2 and 11.3 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 7.

UniStar Nuclear Energy requires additional time to finalize the responses to RAI 290, Question 11.02-5, and RAI 291, Question 11.03-3. Responses to these questions will be provided to the NRC by March 16, 2011.
