Hi Ms. Kiker,

Please accept my apology for missing your returned call. I had called because your letter of January 14, 2011, included a recommendation for a formal public hearing to give citizens an opportunity to address issues concerning the EnergySolutions import and export license applications. My call was to request clarification as to whether your recommendation was for a meeting between the NRC, applicant and citizens in the community or was intended to be considered as a requests to intervene in a hearing on the license requests. Subsequent to my call, I realized that the Citizens Task Force was listed as a supporter of the petition to intervene filed by the Tennessee Environmental Council and others. That petition as well as the letters of comments that have been received are currently under review by Commission advisors. Learning of your support for the petition filed has answered my question. Any adjudication that takes place should afford an opportunity to address issues of concern.
