This amendment approves the release of the facility located on 100 Aniline Avenue, Holland, Michigan for unrestricted use. Based on review of the information provided in your request, we have concluded that any residual byproduct material remaining in the facility is below the NRC's unrestricted use dose limits specified in 10 CFR Part 20, subpart E "Radiological Criteria for License Termination."

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(iii).
