Mr. Slate:

Please take a look at page 1 of Bozeman Deaconess' license. You asked the question whether Items 6.C. (35.300 material) and 6.E. (I-131 use) should be together. The answer is that they need to be together. I don't know why the license was written this way but we can merge these two items into one under the umbrella of 35.300. What I need you to tell me is what is the maximum possession limit you want to list in the license for all 35.300 material (including I-131, Zevalin, Sr-90, etc.). The current 35.300 possession limit is 500 millicuries. Thank you.

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
