UniStar Nuclear Energy (UNE) will submit the Guidance and Strategies using the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) template document NEI 06-12 template and NRC Interim Staff Guidance (ISG) ISG-016.

The referenced letter provided an August 31, 2011 submittal date based on utilizing a template different from NEI 06-12. The UniStar LOLA information, utilizing the NEI 06-12 template, will now be submitted to the NRC by March 31, 2011.

Because some aspects of the NEI 06-12 template have raised concerns, UniStar will be requesting a public meeting to discuss the concerns prior to the March 31 submittal.
