Dear Sirs:

Effective March 1, 2011 Camden-Clark Memorial Hospital Corporation (47-09772) ^{02/14} will be purchasing the assets of St. Joseph's Hospital. The following is information concerning the change of ownership.

- 1) The new name of the hospital will be Camden-Clark Memorial Hospital.
- 2) The licensee contact for administrative issues concerning the transfer of ownership is David K. McClure, V.P. Operations. He may be reached at (304) 424-2131. The contact for technical issues is St. Joseph's Radiation Safety Officer, Mark Perna, who may be reached at (412) 551-9259.
- 3) There will be no changes in personnel having direct control over licensed activities nor any changes in personnel named in the license, such as the radiation safety officer and/or authorized users. A new senior administrative staff will be in place; however, the current technical staff will otherwise remain, at least on a temporary basis.
- 4) There will be no changes in organization, location, facility, equipment or procedures.
- 5) All surveillance items and records are current and will be current at the time of the buy-out.

- 6) We confirm that all records are currently maintained, including those concerning public dose and radioactive spills will be transferred to Camden-Clark Memorial Hospital.
- 7) There are no records concerning decommissioning and no waste has been disposed of by release to sewer, incineration or in-site burial.
- 8) Routine testing for contamination has shown no contamination on site. Only very short-lived isotopes such as Tc-99m and TI-201 are in use on site. Cs-137 is present in sealed form and routine quarterly leak testing has shown that no leakage has occurred.
- 9) There are no open inspection issues at the present time.
- 10) Camden-Clark Memorial Hospital agrees to abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, commitments and representations previously made to the NRC by St. Joseph's Hospital in the existing license.

We hereby request that you expedite this amendment.
