The purpose of this letter is to provide updated schedule information for the submittal of a revision to the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Cyber Security Plan. The plan, which was submitted under Reference 1, is required for compliance with 10 CFR 73.54 and 10 CFR 52.79(36)(iii).

Reference 2 informed the industry that 10 CFR 73.54 "is interpreted to include structures, systems, and components in the balance of plant (BOP) that have nexus to radiological health and safety..." The referenced letter stated that specified changes are needed to cyber security plans under review.

A revision to the CCNPP, Unit 3 Cyber Security Plan incorporating the specified changes will be submitted to the NRC by June 16, 2011.
