The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) received your request through the Service's internet-based Information, Planning, and Conservation (IPaC) decision support system on January 25, 2011 at 1:24 PM. You requested information on federally proposed or listed threatened and endangered species, candidate species, and designated critical habitat that may be affected by your proposed project, referred to as "GSTR License Renewal", as depicted on the enclosed map you generated on the IPaC system.

website at regular intervals during project planning and implementation for updates to species-lists and information. An updated list may be requested through the IPaC system by completing the same process used to receive the enclosed list.


