Pursuant to 10 CFR 73.5, “Specific Exemptions,” Dairyland Power Cooperative (DPC), as licensee, requests exemptions from certain requirements of 10 CFR 73.55 for the LACBWR Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI).

The requested exemptions from the requirements set forth in 10 CFR 73.55 are commensurate with the reduction in risk to the health and safety of the public posed by a stand alone ISFSI. DPC has made good faith efforts to comply with the regulations. These exemptions do not address an immediate security concern, but rather are being submitted to comply with Reference 1 and 2 for implementation of the ISFSI. A similar exemption request, Reference 2, was submitted to the NRC for LACBWR previously in response to Reference 1, and to date, that exemption request remains pending approval.

DPC anticipates that the first fuel-loaded cask will be placed at the ISFSI in late August or early September 2011. Implementation of the ISFSI Security Plan will be completed 90 days prior to this milestone.


