Dear Mr. Chairman:

As required by Section 10a of Title 41 of the United States Code, I am submitting the fiscal year (FY) 2010 Buy American Act Report for the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), as follows:

1. During FY 2010, the NRC purchased articles, materials, or supplies that were manufactured outside the United States in the amount of \$35,373.08.
2. The specific exceptions for items purchased outside the United States include items purchased under the Trade Agreements Act, Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 25.402(a)(1), for items in the amount of \$29,925.00, and under the Commercial Item Information Technology exception, FAR 25.103(e), for items in the amount of \$5,448.08.
3. Procurement funds expended on articles, materials, and supplies manufactured inside the United States totaled \$11,903,878.35 for FY 2010.
4. The total amount of procurement funds expended outside the United States was \$35,373.08.

The NRC looks forward to continuing its support of the Buy American program.
