PILGRIM WATCH MEMORANDUM REGARDING FUKUSHIMA

Today's reports from Japan raises concerns that this Board should consider in connection with issues before it regarding PW's pending contention on the insufficiency of the AMP for submerged non-environmentally qualified electric cables needed to operate safety systems.

The inability to provide electric power to critical safety components appears to be a major contributing factor.

With respect to the remand, initial reports seem to show that, in a coastal location, a released plume does not travel in a straight line; and the area of contamination not limited to 2-miles around and a small portion of a pie-shaped wedge.
