On February 18, 2011, the State of New York filed an "Unopposed Motion For An Extension Of Time To File A Reply To Answers On The State's Motion For Leave To File Amended Bases On Contention 17A/B And For Enlargement Of Page Limitation For The State's Consolidated Answer To Separate Motions For Summary Disposition On Contention 35/36."
