Gentlemen;

This will reply to your letter of November 2, 1965 regarding the additional information you requested in support of our application for renewal of Source Material License STB-258.

Referring to your previous letter dated January 25, 1965, paragraph two, we can advise you that in addition to the equipment we installed for diluting the liquids entering the sewerage system to a satisfactory level, we are arranging with a suitable laboratory to have periodic samples analyzed to determine the amount of concentration of radioactive materials in this diluted waste.

In further reference to your letter of January 25, 1965 paragraph three, we are presently setting up portable Air Sampling Equipment in our plant and arranging for the filters to be sent to a suitable laboratory for periodic analysis to evaluate personnel exposure to airborne radioactivity.

We expect to have the Air Sampling Equipment set up shortly for use in the fabricating and solutioning departments in our plant, followed by the analysis of the filters and waste samples as soon thereafter as possible.
