SCHEDULE UPDATE

REFERENCE: Letter logged TXNB-10029 (Proprietary) from Rafael Flores of Luminant to the NRC, dated March 31, 2010, transmitting a Schedule Update to the Combined License Application for Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Plant, Units 3 and 4.

Dear Sir:

Luminant Generation Company LLC (Luminant) submits herein schedule updates for Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Plant (CPNPP) Units 3 and 4. The most recent schedule for these units was provided in the referenced letter. Since it was submitted, the NRC has issued revisions to the US-APWR certification schedule and the CPNPP Units 3 and 4 COL application review schedule.

On February 24, 2011, the NRC released a revised schedule for review of MHI's design certification application that calls for issuance of the US-APWR design certification in October 2013. The NRC cited extended design certification review in three topical areas as reasons for its decision to extend the review schedule. Subsequently the NRC extended the review schedule for the CPNPP combined license application to November 2013. As members of the US-APWR Design Centered Working Group, MHI, Luminant and Dominion Virginia Power are working together to support timely review completion and issuance of the design certification. The revised COL schedule, along with commercial and pre-COL investment considerations, led Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Company to extend the scheduled commercial operation dates for Units 3 and 4 to Q3 2021 and Q2 2022, respectively.


