SUMMARY

This refers to your letter dated August 25, 2010, application (NRC Form 314) for renewal dated August 25, 2010 (with attachments) and the conversation between Douglas McGregor and Michael Herr on January 11, 2011.

In your letter dated August 25, 2010 you requested that we renew your NRC Material License No. 13-26651-01. **During our review of your application (NRC Form 313) dated August 25, 2010 (with attachments), we noticed that it is incomplete. The Certifying Official section is not signed. Please respond by providing a completed NRC 313 signed by a Certifying Official.**

We also noted in your application dated August 25, 2010, that in the Attached Appendix B that you marked that you will not perform non-routine maintenance on your gauges. However, in Amendment No. 08 of your NRC Material License you were authorized to perform non-routine maintenance in accordance with your letter dated May 25, 1995. Please respond by specifying what your request is regards to the conducting non-routine maintenance.

In Item No. 7 of the attachment to your application for renewal of your license, you accepted the standard response that permits you to "self-appoint" future Radiation Safety Officers (RSOs) who meet specified training and experience requirements. Please note that certain sections of NUREG 1556 Vol. 4, dated October 1998, "Consolidate Guidance about Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance about Fixed Gauge Licenses," has changed since the last revision and can no longer permit you to do this. NRC must amend your license before you change RSOs. To change RSOs you should name the proposed RSO, provide evidence of adequate and appropriate training and experience with the fixed gauges and submit a signed and dated statement that the proposed RSO accepts the position and understands the duties and responsibilities associated with it. Your senior management representative must also sign this statement and delegate authority to the proposed RSO to operate your Radiation Safety Program. Please withdraw the request to self appoint RSOs as you requested in Appendix B Checklist of NUREG 1556 Vol. 4 that was an attachment to your application.

Address your written response to my attention at the above address and please be sure to reference Control No. 573516 to facilitate proper handling in our office. As a reminder, please provide the information requested in writing, accompanied by a transmittal letter that is appropriately dated and signed by a senior management official.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.


