Dear Mr. Manske:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 20 to your NRC Material License No. 48-18672-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

**In your correspondence to us dated February 16, 2011, you indicated that you wished to release for unrestricted use a former address of use and area of use, located at 3839 East Paris Avenue, Grand Rapids, Michigan.**

**The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys, which consisted of leak test results taken from your gauging devices. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your former address of use and area of use, located at 3839 East Paris Avenue, Grand Rapids, Michigan, and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.**

**Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required for this address of use and area of use and they are suitable for unrestricted use.**

**Please note that we added license Condition Nos. 13. F to your NRC Material License. This change should enhance your awareness of the radiation safety program elements in your license and our regulatory requirements.**



You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
