Notice is hereby given that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers as a cooperating agency have published a final environmental impact statement (EIS), NUREG-1939, "Final Environmental Impact Statement for Combined Licenses for Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station, Units 2 and 3: Final Report" for the Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station, Units 2 and 3, Combined Licenses application.

The Draft EIS was published in April 2010; a notice of availability appeared in the *Federal Register* on April 23, 2010 (75 FR 21368). The purpose of this notice is to inform the public that the final EIS is available for public inspection. The final EIS may be viewed online at: www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1939/. In addition, the final EIS is available for inspection in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR) located at One White Flint North, 11555 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Maryland, 20852 or from NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS).
