Dear Mr. Basavatia:

It has come to our attention that an omission existed in Amendment No. 26 to your NRC Material License No. 13-15933-01. This omission has been corrected by the addition of a total possession limit in Items 8.E. and 8.F. in the enclosed Corrected Copy of License Amendment No. 26.

Due to a change in NRC's licensing policies, we must obtain possession limits for all materials listed on your license except materials in 10 CFR 35.100 and 35.200. As we discussed by telephone on March 1, 2011, we have listed the total possession limit for 10 CFR 35.500 as 1 curie in Item 8.E. and the total possession limit for 10 CFR 31.11 materials as 2 millicuires in Item 8.F.
