The wording referring to the general license on both the Nilton Xlp 818 (Serial #12087) and the Niton XL 801S (Serial #U1290) are both exactly the same as follows:

Receipt, possession, use, and transfer, of this device are subject to a general license or equivalent and the regulations of the US NRC or a state with which the NRC has entered into an agreement for the exercise of regulatory authority, or a License State as designated by the CRCPD.

See owners manual for all instructions to ensure safe operation. Must be leak tested each 6 months. Device may not be sold or transferred without notifying the manufacturer. This label shall be maintained on the device in a legible condition. Removal is prohibited.
