

SUMMARY (Continue on Page 2)				
SFST staff contacted NAC to discuss the technical specification (TS) change Tom Danner and Craig Seaman discussed with SFST management.				
TS change -background: The requirement in the MAGNASTOR CoC TS (Appendix A, 4.1.1, Criticality Control, Item d) represents a measurement between two points in space. The measurable dimension is the 13.08-inch fuel tube diagonal dimension that defines the resulting center-to-center dimensions. Since the minimum fuel tube orthogonal pitch is in the TS, full compliance is required with objective evidence.				
Possible Path Forward discussed during this call consisted of the following:				
1. Stop the rulemaking process before publication of MAGNASTOR AMD 2 appears in the Federal Register and address the TS issue.				
2. NAC must request (in writing) the change in TS. This submittal has to be a complete package including technical justification for the change.				
3. After request is received in SFST, it will be entered into the SFST schedule. It is difficult to estimate in advance how long SFST's portion will take (depends on how many technical reviewers, if any, will be involved). Once processed through SFST concurrence, the rulemaking process will start anew. This will take approximately six months with the final rule effective date estimated to be in December 2011. The latter is predicated on there being no delay in the submittal and the submittal being of high quality such that the technical review can proceed promptly without requests for supplemental/additional information.				
4. SFST PM engaged Duke in conversation and was made aware of issues at the McGuire plant that might impact the campaign schedule. To prevent potential misunderstanding resulting from separate conversations a conference call with participants NRC, Duke McGuire, and NAC will be scheduled for Thursday March 24, 2011 at 2:00 PM.				
5. At the time of the conversation the thinking was that the Duke exemption request currently in-house may not need to be modified and that no new exemption request would need to be submitted. This issue may need to be revisited.
