BELLEFONTE NUCLEAR PLANT UNITS 1 AND 2 - SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO VIOLATION 50-438/81-29-01, 50-439/81-29-01 - INADEQUATE FIELD MODIFICATION OF LETDOWN COOLER SUPPORTS

TVA's initial response to R. C. Lewis' letter dated December 8, 1981, report numbers 50-438/81-29, 50-439/81-29 concerning activities at the Bellefonte Nuclear Plant which appeared to have been in violation of NRC regulations was submitted on January 21, 1982, with revised responses submitted on February 10 and June 18, 1982. This was followed by our supplemental responses on June 10 and December 7, 1983. Below is our third supplemental response to the citation.

As discussed with NRC-OIE Inspector P. E. Fredrickson on May 25, 1984, the date of May 30, 1984 for completion of corrective actions indicated in our final report on this matter would not be met.

B&W stud bolts received on site are considered unacceptable for use and are being returned. Also, foundation bolting material ordered by TVA is not expected until August 1984. The corrective action on this matter will be completed by November 11, 1984 for unit 1 and November 11, 1986 for unit 2.
