The purpose of this modification is to (1) extend the current period of performance through June 15, 2011 at no additional cost to the government; (2) to revise the period of performance section to reflect the optional periods; and (3) to add FAR Clauses 52.217-7 and FAR 52.217-9 which were inadvertently omitted from the task order award document.

Accordingly the following changes are made:

1. Section 2. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

## **2. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE**

The period of performance of this order shall be **February 2, 2011 through June 15, 2011**. Should Optional Tasks 2-7 be exercised, the period of performance shall be extended through **November 1, 2012**.

2. The following two sections are hereby incorporated into this task order:

### **7. FAR 52.217-7 OPTION FOR INCREASED QUANTITY--SEPARATELY PRICED LINE ITEM (MAR 1989)**

The Government may require the delivery of the numbered line item, identified in the Schedule as an option item, in the quantity and at the price stated in the Schedule. The Contracting Officer may exercise the option by written notice to the Contractor within the contract period of performance. Delivery of added items shall continue at the same rate that like items are called for under the contract, unless the parties otherwise agree.

### **8. FAR 52.217-9 OPTION TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT. (MAR 2000)**

- (a) The Government may extend the term of this contract by written notice to the Contractor within the period of performance of the task order; provided that the Government gives the Contractor a preliminary written notice of its intent to extend at least **30 days** before the contract expires. The preliminary notice does not commit the Government to an extension.
- (b) If the Government exercises this option, the extended contract shall be considered to include this option clause.
- (c) The total duration of this contract, including the exercise of any options under this clause, shall not exceed **18 months**.
