Dear Mr. Reuter:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 05 to your NRC Material License No. 13-32079-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please note we cannot authorize the release of your "old" storage area located at 7478 Shadeland Station Way, Indianapolis, Indiana until we have received and reviewed a copy of the results of your close-out survey once the move is completed.

The copies of the leak test that you provided will be sufficient as long as the move takes place within the required interval for leak testing. We will also need verification that all devices have been removed from the 7478 Shadeland Station Way, Indianapolis, Indiana location, and confirmation that there was no leaking sources while you occupied the above location. If there were leaking sources please call me at 630-829-9752 to discuss additional steps that will need to be taken to close out the location.

We also removed License Condition No. 13 since it is redundant now that your NRC Materials license contains possession limit. This required us to renumber subsequent license conditions.

In accordance with 10 Code of Federal Regulations 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order
