Dear Mr. Miller:

This letter is submitted in response to your letter of September 25, 1997 regarding your recent inspection of Jaworski Geotech, Inc. (JGI)'s nuclear program which identified areas where we were out of compliance with Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requirements.

**Violation A.:**

We have no additional response to this violation, as your description accurately reflects our corrective actions.

**Violations B.1., B.2., and C.:**

(1) Each of these violations are the result of our staff not following requirements set forth by our license.

(2) On September 29 and October 1, meetings were held with our entire technical staff, during which these matters were discussed - stressing the importance of compliance. Additionally, copies of both your letter and this response will be distributed to our gauge operators to reinforce the message.

(3) Our technical staff meets semi-annually as part of our regularly scheduled Total Quality Management program. Future meetings will include a review of license requirements as a regular agenda item.

(4) As of this writing, we believe that we are in full compliance.


During the August 5 inspection in our Manchester, New Hampshire office, the improvement of our gauge-tracking documentation was discussed.
