Dear Mr. Elliott:

On February 7, 2011, Nuclear Fuel Services, Inc. (NFS) submitted Revision 15 of the Emergency Plan to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). In its letter, NFS stated that the changes in Revision 15 do not decrease the effectiveness of the Plan, consistent with the requirements in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), Section 70.32(i).

The NRC staff concluded that the submittal is technically sufficient to begin a detailed safety review. Please note that the complete review may require requests for additional information (RAI). Based on projection of current review schedules, we anticipate completing our review by late August 2011. This date could change depending on the findings of our technical review, RAI response times, or other factors. We will promptly communicate any significant changes to this schedule. Please refer to the above Technical Assignment Control Number in all correspondence associated with this action.

In the letter, NFS also indicated that the proposed revisions contained Official Use Only information that is not suitable for public release. The NRC staff completed its withholding determination of the proposed revisions and concludes that such information should not be disclosed to the public. Therefore, only the transmittal letter will be made "publicly available."

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records System component of the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS).
