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SUMMARY

This refers to your letter received December 17, 2010, the message that I left on your voice mail on March 8, 2011, and your email dated March 8, 2011. During our review of your letter received December 17, 2010, we noted that insufficient information was provided to complete our review.

**In your letter dated December 17, 2010, you requested we add two locations of use to your NRC Material License and stated that you "presume" that they fall under federal jurisdiction. In Section 2 of NUREG 1556, Vol. 1, "Consolidated Guidance about Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance about Portable Gauge Licenses, Rev. 1," the NRC places the responsibility of finding out the status of the specific areas of operations as stated below:**

"NRC has regulatory authority over land determined to be "exclusive Federal jurisdiction," while the Agreement State has jurisdiction over non-exclusive Federal jurisdiction land. Licensees are responsible for finding out, in advance, the jurisdictional status of the specific areas where they plan to conduct licensed operations"

**Please provide the status of the two locations (1125 Garwood Lane, Idleyld Park, Oregon and 650 T. Huebner Road {Fort Riley Hospital}, Fort Riley, Kansas) you are requesting to add to your NRC Material License.**

Please submit the requested information within 5 calendar days (by March 16, 2011) by referencing control number **574151** to facilitate proper handling. Upon receipt of your response we will resume our review. Address your written response to my attention at the above address. If we do not receive an adequate response by this date, we will **VOID** the current action without attempting to contact you further and without prejudice to resubmission of your request at a later date.

Upon receipt of your response we will reactivate placement of your request in our database and resume our review. Address your written response to my attention at the above address.


