In Reference 1 Westinghouse Electric Company LLC (Westinghouse) requested NRC authorization for 10 CFR 20.2002 alternate waste disposal of building demolition debris. In conjunction with that request, exemptions from the regulations of 10 CFR 30.3 and §70.3 were also requested. Westinghouse determined that the anticipated timing of NRC approval of the Reference 1 request would not meet Westinghouse's needs. Therefore, the request of Reference 1 is hereby withdrawn.

References 2 and 3, which provided information concerning the Reference 1 request, are accordingly also withdrawn. References 2 and 3 indicated that revised scaling factors resulting from the 2010 sampling of process building walls would be submitted separately. In light of the withdrawal of the References 1 through 3, Westinghouse does not now intend to submit the revision to Westinghouse technical basis document HDP-TBD-WM-901, "Scaling Factors for Radioactive Waste Associated with the Process Buildings" associated with that request.
