Enclosed is Amendment No. 10 to your NRC Material License No. 24-20089-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

**Please note that we reformatted License Condition No. 9 to conform to our standardize formatting of our licenses. This change should have no impact on your radiation protection program.**

**Please also note that we removed both License Condition Nos. 12. B and 18 as the appeared in Amendment No 09 of your NRC Material License.**

**Due to an NRC policy change, you will not be able to change and name your Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) internally as Condition No. 12. B previously allowed. NRC must do that for you via the amendment process.**

**For future RSO changes please submit the name of the proposed RSO; his/her training and experience qualifications; a statement signed and dated by the proposed RSO that s/he accepts the position as RSO and that s/he understands the duties and responsibilities associated with the RSO position.**

**License Condition No. 18 is no longer needed since your NRC Material License now contains possession limits.**

**Lastly, we updated your license by adding License Condition No. 13. E and modifying License Condition No. 14. These changes should enhance your awareness of the radiation safety program elements in your license and our regulatory requirements.**

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
