Dear Mr. Penn:

By letter dated April 1, 2011, Big State X-Ray, Inc. informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of their intentions to terminate NRC radioactive materials license 35-21144-01. You stated your current inventory of radioactive material will remain under your current Oklahoma license and you attached the license for review. The decision to terminate was due to the fact that you have minimal work activity in NRC jurisdiction. Furthermore, you state your awareness of having to file for reciprocity before you perform any activity using byproduct material in NRC jurisdiction.

Please find enclosed Amendment Number 12 to License No. 35-21144-01, authorizing your license termination. An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20).
