10:30 I spoke with the receptionist who indicated that Marcos Arocho-Ramirez, RSO had left the employ of the licensee over a year ago. She determined that Carlos Sierra, President was now the appropriate person to speak with regarding the NRC license. However, Mr. Sierra was at a meeting and would have to return my call.

11:50 I spoke with Mr. Sierra. I informed Mr. Sierra that my phone call was in reference to the company's NRC license which was due to expire on April 30, 2011, and, as of this time, no renewal application had been received by the NRC. He told me that the renewal application was being worked on and that he had spoken to Craig Gordon a few weeks ago about the renewal application. I asked Mr. Sierra about when Mr. Arocho-Ramirez left the company, if they possessed any radium gauges, and when the amendment for the RSO and the renewal application could be expected. In order: Mr. Aroco- Ramirez left the company in November 2010, the company did not have any radium gauges, the amendment could be completed today and the renewal application could be completed early next week. Lastly, I went over some changes to expect when the license was amended: LC 11 and 12 would be changed to standard language and LC 13 would be deleted as it is no longer needed. I thanked Mr. Sierra for his time and attention to this matter
