Subject: PRB Decision on Your Request for Immediate Action (G20110197; TAC No. ME5985)

Mr. Linton, in your March 16, 2011, petition filed by email under 10 CFR 2.206, you requested the "...immediate closure of U.S. nuclear energy facilities that remain operational after having exceeded their engineered operable life. Please immediately close these facilities for inspection in an orderly manner..."

On April 4, 2011, the Petition Review Board (PRB) met to discuss your request for immediate action. The PRB determined that your request for immediate action is a general assertion without supporting facts. The PRB did not identify any new information provided by you that would warrant the NRC to order immediate shutdown of nuclear power reactors.

The PRB meeting on April 4 was only to consider your request for *immediate* action. The board has not met yet to consider your petition in its entirety.
