In order to fully complete this amendment we must have your consent to serve as the Radiation Safety Officer and a statement that you accept the duties and responsibilities associated with the RSO position.

Please submit a written statement, signed and currently dated, attesting to the above. Within 30 days of the date of this letter, please send your written response to my attention as "additional information to control number 574189" to facilitate proper handling in our offices. My address is show above.

Please also provide your direct line telephone number, a fax number and your work email address, so we can locate you and communicate better with you in the future.

For future information, we will always need the same information for any new proposed RSO, i.e., a statement that s/he accepts the position as RSO and that s/he understands the duties and responsibilities associated with that position.

In accordance with 10 Code of Federal Regulations 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC Web site at http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you.

This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
