SUMMARY

We reviewed the requesting amendment request and found that we were unable to continue this licensing action until we received additional information concerning the items noted below:

- (1) Each Authorized User will be updated to reflect the license condition that the use of 35.300 materials is limited to 33 millicuries or less of sodium iodide I-131. This modification also reflects the preceptor attestation, submitted as part of the amendment request, concerning training in radiation safety, regulatory issues, and emergency procedures.

 RESPONSE: No further action is required at this time.
- (2) Current NRC policy requires a possession limit for materials authorized under 10 CFR 31.11. RESPONSE: The licensee confirmed via phone that 5 millicuries is an acceptable possession limit. No further action is required at this time.
