Subject: Security Plan for USEC Headquarters

Mr. Siurano,

USEC letter GDP-09-0039 dated December 21, 2009, requested NRC review and approval of a proposed change to the United States Enrichment Corporation (USEC) "Security Plan for the Protection of Classified Matter at USEC Headquarters".

Per the phone conversation of March 16, 2011, between USEC Headquarters staff (Weidner, Miner, Gorrie and Grosman) and NRC staff (Siurano, Smith and Everly), USEC will prepare a revised security plan for the protection of classified matter at USEC's Bethesda headquarters facility following the guidance provided in the NRC document titled "Standard Practice Procedures Plan: Standard Format And Common Set Of Requirements For The Protection Of Classified Matter For USEC Inc. And Its Limited Liability Companies Regulated By The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission," which was mailed to Mr. Peter Miner during the week of March 7-11, 20. We expect to submit the revised plan for NRC review and approval before July 15, 2011.

During the phone conversation, we also discussed whether the plan should continue to reflect the United States Enrichment Corporation as the possessing entity at USEC's Bethesda Headquarters or, alternatively, whether the plan should reflect the Corporation's parent, USEC Inc., as a possessing entity. We intend to reflect USEC Inc. as a possessing entity in the revised plan and will provide additional details concerning the change of possessing entities in our submittal letter.

Consequently, we withdraw our request for review contained in our letter GDP-09-0039 dated December 21, 2009, Revision 13 of the Security Plan for the Protection of Classified Matter at USEC Headquarters.
