Gentlemen,

I'm sending this from home on account of my email problems at work. Several of my NEI messages have not reached their recipients. I sent this to you from NEI on Friday. Please let me know if you received it.

In general, we think the draft template for the 52.99 FRN is pretty good and it provides useful context for members of the public that will assist their understanding of its purpose. In that regard, we have one comment for your consideration and discussion with OGC: To further help the public understand the larger context/process, the template and each 52.99 FRN should include boilerplate language that briefly explains the public's opportunity to raise questions of ITAAC noncompliance, i.e., explains the 52.103 process. Basically, anticipate and answer the question, "What do I do if I don't agree this ITAAC is met?"

One minor edit – In the table of available documents, clearly identify the "ITAAC Completion Letter" from Southern ..., and you should update the title of this item and the ADAMS number to reference the revised ICL submitted in March.

Thank you for the opportunity to review and comment on the draft template for 52.99 FRNs.
