**DOE to Adopt NRC FEIS for the Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility  
– Bonneville County, Idaho**

Pursuant to Section 1703 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is considering a loan guarantee for the proposed Areva Enrichment Services LLC Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility in Bonneville County, Idaho. DOE's records indicate that you may be an interested party regarding this proposed facility.

As part of its decision-making process DOE intends to adopt the Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) for the Proposed Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility that was issued in February 2011 by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). As required by National Environmental Policy Act regulations at 40 CFR 1506.3(b), DOE will recirculate this EIS as a Final EIS for 30 days following publication of the notice of adoption in the Federal Register. DOE expects the Federal Register notice to be published in the near future.
