Dante: This event was closed out in report No. 03000842/2005-001 (DNMS) dated 3/22/2005. The licensee's corrective actions included: (1) stop all LDR brachytherapy treatments until all individuals are trained, and (2) modify their procedures to incorporate a dual verification system.

NMED Event 050065 involves a medical event where a female patient received an under dose to the treatment site and more to than expected to an unintended site. No wonder the question sounded interesting for a leaking source.

I also agree with your concern about having to provide information to us a second time when it is already in an existing report. I wish we could use the investigation reports, but they are non-public. If the NMED ever goes non-public or the reports ever go public, we will have quite the backfit to perform.
