To Ms. Marida and Mr. Blackburn,

Last night the Office of the Secretary established a docket for the filing of a petition to intervene or a request for hearing with respect to the license transfer application of USEC. Mr. Blackburn was also sent information on requesting a digital certificate which is necessary for accessing the NRC form used for uploading pleadings in NRC proceedings. Notwithstanding your request in writing for a hearing, the proceeding would have to start with a filing submitted to the NRC e-filing system.

But before you take that route, we in the Office of the Secretary need to know whether you are interested in an adjudication which is a contested hearing requiring the submission of pleadings to establish your position, or whether you are interested in a meeting with NRC staff and the licensee in the community near the plant. Often the Office of the Secretary will receive a hearing request when a meeting as described above is the intention of the requester. Thus, if you can confirm that you desire an adjudication before an Atomic Safety and Licensing Board or the Commission please advise. If you would like a meeting between the NRC staff and the community instead, we will pass your request to our Office of Public Affairs to start the meeting process.

Please let us know soon the filing deadline for an adjudication is December 7th.
