SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR DESIGNEE TO SUPPORT THE U.S. NUCLEAR
REGULATORY COMMISSION'S STRATEGIC SUSTAINABILITY PLAN
AND CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION POLICY REQUIREMENTS

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has been tasked along with all Federal government agencies to integrate its Strategic Sustainability Plan (ADAMS ML100090023) to meet the statutory and legal requirements of Executive Order 13423 (EO), "Strengthening Federal Environmental, Energy, and Transportation Management," and EO 13514, "Federal Leadership in Environmental, Energy, and Economic Performance." EO 13423 and EO13514 seek to establish an integrated strategy towards sustainability and climate change adaptation in the Federal government. Section 8(i) of EO 13514 requires as part of the formal strategic sustainability performance planning process, that each Federal agency evaluate their climate change risks and vulnerabilities to manage both the short and long-term effects of climate change on the agency's mission and operations.

As the Senior Official for Climate Change Adaptation Planning, input is required from offices and regions. Please designate a senior level staff person to represent your office/region via e-mail to Bahman Rowhani by June 30, 2011.

During calendar year 2011, designated NRC representatives may be required to participate in interagency climate change workshops (via webinar) sponsored by the Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ). The purpose of the workshops are to collect and share within the office and across major program elements, information relevant to the impact of climate change on your office/region, the agency mission, programs, and operations. Information collected will enable the agency to submit a preliminary high-level analysis of its vulnerability to climate change to CEQ by the September 30, 2011, due date.
