Dear Dr. Stevens:

It has come to our attention that an omission existed in Amendment No. 44 to your NRC Material License No. 24-18287-01. This omission has been corrected by the addition of a total possession limit in Item 8.F. in the enclosed Corrected Copy of License Amendment No. 44.

Due to a change in NRC's licensing policies, we must obtain possession limits for all materials listed on your license except materials in 10 CFR 35.100 and 35.200. As discussed with Andrew Martin, Chief Nuclear Medicine Technologist by telephone on March 21, 2011, we have listed the total possession limit for the materials authorized in 10 CFR 31.11 as 2 millicuries in Item 8.F.
