Dear Ms. Harris:

This refers to your letter dated December 27, 2010, received in our offices March 23, 2011, requesting termination of NRC License No. 12-24846-01.

We are unable to approve your request for termination of the license because the information in your letter was insufficient to complete our review.

If you wish to pursue this request, please prepare a written response to the items below that is currently dated and signed by a senior management representative, addressed to my attention as "additional information to control number 574732," to facilitate proper processing in our offices. It is also strongly recommended that you complete an NRC Form 314, enclosed, with your response.

As we cannot issue your amendment at this time we are voiding your request, i.e., taking it out of our active database. This action is taken without prejudice to resubmission at a later date.

1. Your letter dated December 27, 2010, was not signed. We cannot process any request that is not signed, legibly, by a senior management representative.
2. It appears that you are still in possession of licensed material. To ensure that the materials are not inadvertently transported and used in states where NRC has jurisdiction, please describe how you will ensure that licensed activities will no longer take place.

For example, will all licensed materials be securely locked and the keys/access controlled to prevent removal?

Will all workers involved with licensed materials be trained, and a records maintained of this training, to prevent removal of the sources?

3. Your letter indicates that your intention is to "terminate the NRC license prior to renewal fees being applied."

NRC does not charge renewal fees for its licenses. Your license is not scheduled to expire until November 30, 2012. NRC does assess annual fees for its active licenses. It is my understanding (which could be mistaken because I'm not in Fees) that an active

license is one that is in effect on the first day of the federal government's fiscal year, which for Fiscal Year FY 2011 was October 1, 2010.

Your license was active, i.e., not terminated already, on October 1, 2010. Therefore, it appears that the annual fee assessed, which you enclosed a copy of with your December 27, 2010, letter, is correct.

If you have questions concerning your fee payment or status please contact Ms. Brenda Brown at (301)-415-6055. Ms. Brown is a License Fees Specialist located in our Rockville, Maryland headquarters offices. She is not a region-based employee, as I, Colleen Casey, am.

4. My numerous attempts to reach you at the telephone numbers in various documents in your NRC files proved futile. Therefore I am sending you this letter.

Please include the name, telephone number and fax number of at least once knowledgeable individual authorized to answer questions pertaining to the NRC license.

5. It is my understanding, from reviewing your recent inspection report, that your Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) of record, Mr. Robert Harris, passed away recently. We are very sorry for your loss.

Please also note that you must have a qualified RSO in order to have an NRC license and to conduct licensed activities.


Please advise us immediately if you are still conducting any licensed activities so we can discuss with you the potential replacement of the RSO.
