On October 27, 2005, you requested the following information on the above event:

(1) What corrective action(s) were taken by the licensee to prevent a recurrence?

Licensee developed and implemented new procedures for the administration of Yttrium-90 to ensure that the amount administered was between -5 percent and +15 percent of the prescribed amount. Training was provided to all personnel involved in the treatments in the revised procedures.

(2) What was the determined dose given to the patient?

The determined dose to the patient for this type of procedure is measured in millicuries, i.e., the patient dosage was 6.8 millicuries.

The NRC has concluded its review of the circumstances surrounding the event and determined that escalated enforcement action is not necessary. See ML060530157. As a result, this NMED Event may be closed if you do not require any further information.
